

Preamble

A lack of funding should not deter anyone from applying to Leadership West Yellowhead. The program has limited funds designated to offset the tuition for successful applicants who are not able to cover the \$1,750 program fee. The selection process for entry into the program is in no way influenced by an application for financial assistance. However, we cannot guarantee that your request will be filled.

Other sources of funding

We receive many more requests for tuition assistance than we can meet. Applicants seeking tuition assistance are **STRONGLY** encouraged to be innovative in looking elsewhere in the community for support. An application for assistance should only be made after other potential sources of funds have been exhausted. As such, we ask that you provide us with information on your efforts to this end.

Funding Priority

Consideration for assistance is based on demonstrated need. Funds will be allocated according to the following priority order: 1) non-profit sector; 2) self-employed; 3) retired; 4) unemployed; 5) public sector; and 6) private sector.

Amount of assistance

Financial assistance towards program fees may be provided **to a maximum of \$1300.**

Decisions on assistance

Every request will receive a thorough and fair assessment only after the program's selection process has been completed. Your request for financial assistance will in no way influence the selection decision for entry into the program. This is a confidential application to ensure that selection decisions are fair and unbiased.

How to apply
